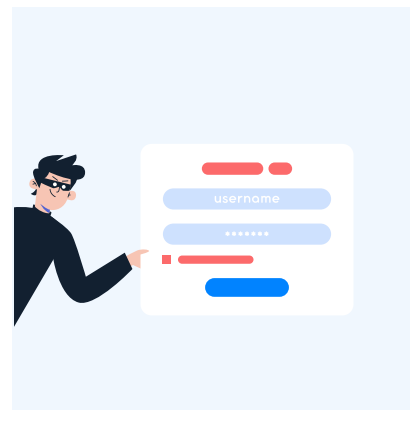


Your Guide to Indonesia's Personal Data Protection Law

On 20th September 2022, Indonesia's first comprehensive law protecting personal data got approved – the Personal Data Protection Law.



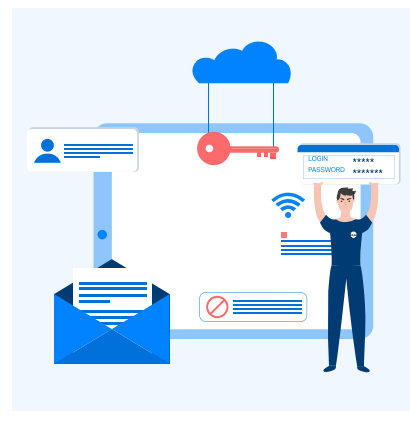
Facts You Need to Know

Key Roles You Should Know



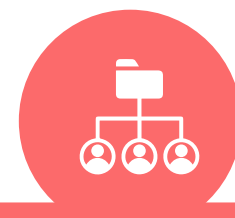
Data Processor

Party that processes personal data on behalf of the controller of personal data.



Data Controller

Party that determines the purpose and exercises control over the processing of personal data.



Data Owner

Individual who has the personal data attached to themselves.

Key Highlights of the Bill

Cross-Border Data Transfer



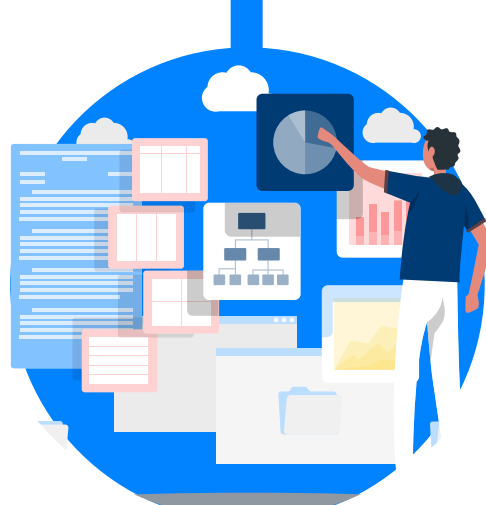
The controller may transfer personal data outside Indonesia based on the following criteria:

- The rate of data protection is equal or higher than the bill.
- An international agreement exists between countries.
- A contract is signed between the data controllers.
- There is explicit approval from the data owner.

Non Compliance Penalty (For Orgs)



- Hefty fine up to IDR 60 billion can be imposed
- Confiscation of profits and/or assets.
- Permanent prohibition of certain actions.
- Closure of all or parts of a place of business and/or activity.



Obligations of Data Controllers

- Obtain explicit consent and maintain log of consent
- Supervise the data processor.
- Ensure processing is in line with consented purpose and maintain record of processing.
- Notify the data owner and the Minister of any data breach.
- Hold accountability for processing activities in accordance with the draft law.

Obligation of Data Processors

- Comply with the law's requirements and instructions from the controller.
- Maintain confidentiality, accuracy and consistency of personal data.
- Maintain record of processing.
- Prevent unauthorized processing and access to personal data in an invalid manner.
- Supervise every party involved in processing.
